7 STEPS TO WELL-BEING RESILIENCE
Resilience is the ability to face challenges and 'bounce back'.
What can you do?

1. Ask what went well each day in school – don't focus on the negatives
2. Be a good role model of how to deal with set backs in a positive way
3. Encourage the trait of persistence 'can do not can't do...try and try again (this is useful in all aspects of learning)
4. Allow children to try and solve their own problems – don't be too quick to jump in and sort the situation yourself
5. Encourage positivity and optimism help children to focus on what they have, not on what they don't have
6. Allow children to make mistakes and then find a solution (this is a good skill to have when dealing with fall outs between friends as well)
7. Find situations when children need to be brave and push their comfort zone! Try new activities.
