



# MELLING IN FOCUS REWARDS & AWARDS

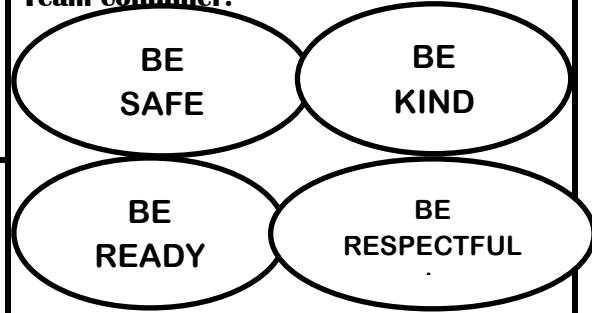


## WE HAVE HIGH EXPECTATIONS – REWARDS & AWARDS HELP US TO MAINTAIN THEM:
