STRONGER START TO YOUR CHILD'S NEW CLASS

You will find a powerpoint on the class page entitled 'Strong Start to...' – this gives you all the information you need to enable your child to have a strong start to their new class. Please ensure that you and your child have read through this together before our return.

SCHOOL BAGS, PENCIL CASES & WATER BOTTLES

The only bag required for each child, is their book bag. If another bag is required, it should be the school ruck-sack, with a name label on it. We do not have the space to store oversized bags for every child. Children do not need a pencil case so should not need to bring one into school. Water bottles should be of standard size.

UNIFORM & PE KIT

The school uniform must be adhered to: including all black sensible shoes; Y3 upwards wear a shirt and tie; earrings should be studs; hair of just above shoulder length must be tied back (boys & girls); no jewellery should be worn; coloured hair braids from summer holidays should be removed before our return in September; no nail varnish/false nails; no tattoos.

START & FINISH TIMES

The gate will open at just before **8.45** each morning and will close just before **8.55** – to ensure all children are in class by 8.55am.

YR Y1 Y2 finish their day at **3.05pm** and should be collected from their classroom. Y3 Y4 Y5 Y6 finish at **3.15pm** – Y3 parents/carers should collect their child from the playground; Y4 & Y6 leave via the side path and Y5 leave via the main gate. **Please ensure your child is on time – the gate will now close at 8.53 so that all children can be learning at 8.55am.**

WALKING HOME FROM SCHOOL

Only children in Y5 and Y6 will be allowed to walk home from school. A permission form must be completed beforehand.

ORDERING SCHOOL LUNCHES

Please ensure lunches for the first week are booked in plenty of time.

ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

Children with 92% and under attendance will be monitored by the attendance officer on a weekly basis.

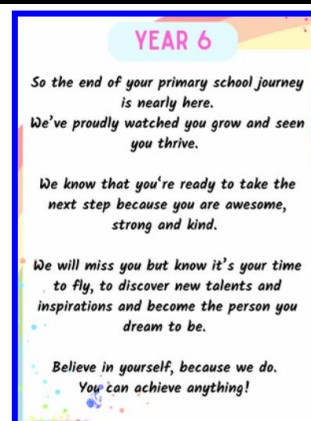
